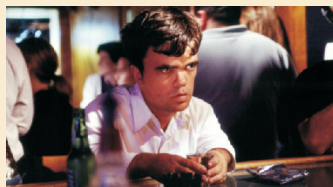

Cate Shortland - Germany 2012 (109 min)



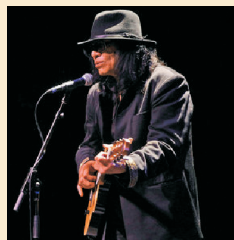

Thomas Vinterberg - Denmark 2012 (115 min)



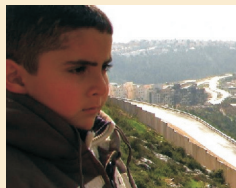
