## SUNSHINE ON LEITH (PG) Dr / Mu

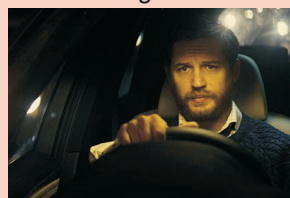
Dexter Fletcher - UK 2013 (100 min)

**20 FEET FROM STARDOM** (12A)Morgan Neville - UK 2013 (91 min) **Do / Mu**

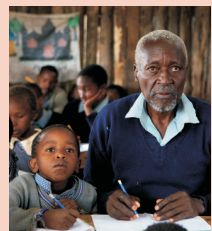
