

Dir: Bruce Beresford - Aus. 2009 (117 min)

A drama based on the autobiography of Li Cunxin. At the age of eleven, Li was plucked from a poor Chinese village by Madame Mao's cultural delegates and taken to Beijing to study ballet. In 1979, during a cultural exchange to Texas, he fell in love with an American woman.
